

Minutes Inland Empire Antique and Classic Boat Club

October 19, 2023

Club's Drone. In 2018 the club purchased a drone. Since that time regulations have mushroomed and now include no fly zones, various FAA regulations including requirements for a pilot's license. These complications were extensively discussed. To keep it available to the club it was recommended that ownership be transferred to Mitch Johnson. The motion was made by Petyr Beck and seconded by Dennis Riggs. It was unanimously approved
